## MOTHERHOOD AS AN ILLUSTRATION

When a mother is mentioned, what qualities come to your mind? One reason why this is a worthwhile question is that the Psalms often use motherhood to illustrate key truths about God and our relationship to him. What is it that, according to the songs and prayers of Israel, should impress us and stay with us?

*The power and knowledge of God.* "For you formed my inward parts; you knitted me together in my mother's womb....My frame was not hidden from you, when I was being made in secret, intricately woven in the depths of the earth. Your eyes saw my unformed substance; in your book were written, every one of them, the days that were formed for me, when as yet there were none of them" (Psalm 139:13, 15-16).

*The trustworthiness of God.* "O LORD, my heart is not lifted up; my eyes are not raised too high; I do not occupy myself with things too great and too marvelous for me. But I have calmed and quieted my soul, like a weaned child with his mother; like a weaned child is my soul within me" (Psalm 131:1-2).

*The kindness of God.* "He raises the poor from the dust and lifts the needy from the ash heap....He gives the barren woman a home, making her the joyous mother of children. Praise the LORD!" (Psalm 113:7, 9).

*The necessity of God.* "Upon you I have leaned from before my birth; you were he who took my from my mother's womb. My praise is continually of you....For I know my transgressions, and my sin is ever before me....Behold, I was brought forth in iniquity, and in sin did my mother conceive me....I went about as though I grieved for my friend or my brother; as one who laments his mother, I bowed down in mourning (Psalm 71:6; 51:3, 5; 35:14).

*The steadfast love of God.* "Hide not your face from me. Turn not away from your servant in anger, O you who have been my help. Cast me not off; forsake me not, O God of my salvation! For my father and my mother have forsaken me, but the LORD will take me in....Yet you are he who took me from the womb; you made me trust you at my mother's breasts. On you I was cast from my birth, and from my mother's womb you have been my God" (Psalm 27:9-10; 22:9-10).

Perhaps the greatest gift a mother can give to her children is a background against which to understand themselves in relation to the Lord GOD.

## EQUALS

There is a mathematical equation which goes like this: "Things which are equal to themselves are equal to each other." This applies to the church and salvation. First, in talking about the church, Luke informs us that the "church of God was purchased by his own blood" (Acts 20:28). Next, the Apostle Paul declares, "we have redemption through his (meaning Christ's) blood" (Eph. 1:7; Col. 1:14). These two verses verify that God and Christ are one in keeping with 1<sup>st</sup> John 5:7-8. There is more! If the Lord's blood purchased the church and if the saved were redeemed by his blood, then it stands to reason that one equals the other and each depends on each other. In plain English, if we remove the saved, there is no church and if we remove the church, then there is no saved! Perhaps this is why we see in Ephesians 5:23 that Paul wrote, "and he (Christ) is the savior of the body" (meaning the church - Eph. 1:22, 23, Col. 1:18). Please search these passages for yourself! Now, let's go a step further: If the church in the first century **was visible** (Rome, Corinth, etc.) then it must also be **visible today**. Think about this: If the **saved never assembled** there is **no visible church**. If there is **no visible church**, there is **no saved**! Scripturally speaking they are the same. Luke must have known this in writing, "and the Lord added to the church daily such as should be saved" (Acts 2:47). Our efforts must focus on things which are equal!
