GOD IS NOT MOCKED

Reflecting back over my childhood, I recall a scene from the one-room schoolhouse where the community's children had assembled for learning. It was the opening period for the day when "Miss Della," our teacher, required each student from first grade through the sixth to recite a scripture from the bible. Galatians 6:7 was often heard. "Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap." Children of that era - across the whole nation - were taught to have respect for God and mankind. It was drilled into their minds the terrribleness of making fun of anyone and especially the God of heaven. Along with the Galatians passage the "Golden Rule" from Luke 6:31 was also very popular. Things have changed over the years! The great attribute of respect for others (especially God and his holy commandments) has all but vanished from the vocabulary of many. In its place, especially in the entertainment world, there is little respect for the name of God and if He is mentioned at all, it would be in a disrespectful manner. For example: Songs of solemnity have been changed to excite the carnal passions of humanity while the law of modesty and decency has often given place to vulgarity and ridicule. Going back to the last words of that noted scripture, we would do well to remember "for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap." Also this - "The wicked shall be turned into hell, and all nations that forget God" (Psa.9:17).
