DELIVERANCE FROM HEARTACHE AND GRIEF

To know the true meaning of loving one another comes to God's people when they have been blessed by the beautiful tie that binds their hearts in Christian love. 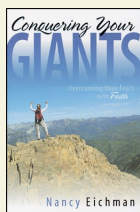

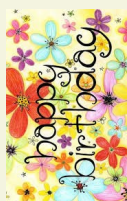
