YOU KNOW - GOD REALLY DOES KNOW!

Sometimes I think today's generation has come so far away from God that they not only cease to believe that He is that all-wise, merciful, loving and forgiving God but question whether there really is a God. Be it known dear reader, the Bible assures us of all the above. Of the many things which God knows is whether we belong to him as his children or not. The Apostle Paul wrote, "Nevertheless the foundation of God standeth sure, having this seal, The Lord **knoweth** them that are his, and let everyone that nameth the name of Christ depart from iniquity" (2nd Tim. 2:19).
